#### RECEPTION

Children will be to

Children will be able to:

#### YEAR 2

Children will be able to:

- Recognise numbers up to 100.
- Continue correct formation of letters and handwriting.
- Complete tasks pertaining to the numbers
- Look at the formation of letters at the beginning, middle and end of a word.
- Understand classroom instructions in Arabic and respond

#### YEAR 3

Children will be able to:

- Recognise the numbers in tens.
- Make any number up to 100
- Recognise the Arabic numerals
- Listen to Arabic dialect and follow the story line

#### YEAR 4

Children will be able to:

- Recognise the time
- Recognise how to say and write quarter past, half past, quarter to.
- Complete tasks pertaining to time
- Recognise AM an PM

#### YEAR 5

Children will be able to:

- Recognise the different furniture in the house.
- Make descriptive sentences of one's home and the furniture inside it
- Comprehension sentences pertaining to the home

Children will be able to:

- Recognise clothing.
- Understand how to make correct grammatical sentences using colours and clothing.
- Translate sentences pertaining to clothing into Arabic
- Comprehension sentences pertaining to clothing.
