Literacy

Fiction Genres-In this fiction part of this Unit children study a play script, The Elephant in the Room, which is about a child-carer. The author Lou Kuenzler uses dramatic conventions, such as monologue, to involve the audience and create atmosphere whilst exploring characters and the stages of a script.
