We continue to follow advice received from the Department for Education and Public Health England. In line with government guidance regarding safeguarding and the health and safety of students, we have made the decision to close the school. This decision has been made in light of the fact that a number of our staff members have been advised to self-isolate. It is important at this stage to note that we do not have any confirmed COVID –19 cases at the school.

After careful consultation with the SLT and the Trustee Management, we have collectively decided that it would be in the best interest of all our students and staff to close the school indefinitely as of **Thursday 19th March 2020**. This will remain in effect until we receive further direction from the DfE and Public Health England.

Please be rest assured that the staff have been working diligently to ensure plans are in place for a school closure.

Alhamdulillah, we have created google classroom access for every student which will enable all our students to access learning remotely from home.

In the following days, all students will be provided with their unique google classroom login/password details via email Insha'Allah.

However, if you are able to physically collect the passwords/learning packs, please feel free to collect paper copies from the main office tomorrow and Friday between the hours, 10am – 4pm.
