End of term

Keep on learning

- Learning will resume from Monday 20th April, 10:00 am
- Many of you have concerns regarding the learning gaps that will result from our school closure and I also share these concerns. This is why we have put together this unique remote learning plan to ensure our students continue to access teaching and learning remotely.
- I am confident that if your child engages with the teaching the school is providing, we will be ahead of the curve when we insha'Allah the school reopens.
- With this in mind, please be aware of how engaged your child is. Please do let the school know if your child needs help or further support during this time.
- Year 11: There has been no announcement as of yet about how grades will be

determined. It is likely to be a combination of factors. We are committed to continue to teach our Year 11s to give them the best start to life beyond secondary school. It is important they continue to be engaged with their learning and your support with this is much appreciated. I will be in touch as soon as I have more concrete information regarding Year 11 qualifications.

- We will also be sending out a structured revision timetable and introducing 'zoom' sessions for all our Year 11 students. This will enable our teachers to focus on particular areas of learning and enable targeted teaching.
