- Develop strong literacy and numeracy skills so that pupils have a global outlook and are ready and confident for the next stage of their lives.

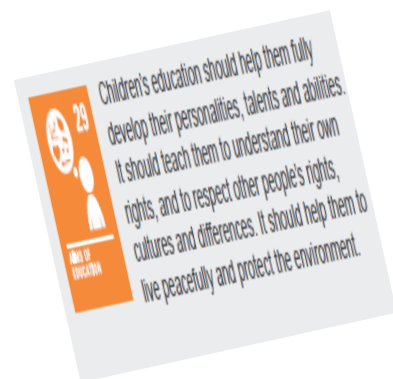
For our first 'Drop Down Day' the focus will be on the 'Caring for Our Education' learning Driver and UNCRC Article 29

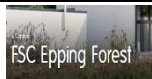
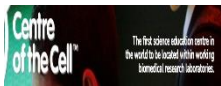
Caring for Our Education
