	Personal, Social, Emotional Development Within our early years settings children will be subjected to positive environments which ensure that they feel safe and secure. This provides a platform for learners to make relationships and gain confidence in their abilities and learning.	Communication and Language Children will be provided with a range of scenarios that allow them to listen, speak and understand language effectively. Whilst developing these key skills children will be subjected to a wide range of vocabulary to deepen their understanding.	Literacy Learners at QUIGS will develop early reading skills which will provide them with the right steps to be independent readers. Children will develop positive attitudes in relation to reading and writing and be provided with opportunities and experiences which allow them to develop a life-long love for literacy.
	Physical Development QUIGS pupils will develop a wide range of physical skills with focus on fine and gross motor movements. Skills should be developed to ensure children are prepared for their next step in education and allow them to be happy and healthy whilst doing so.	Understanding the World When exploring the world around them, children will develop an understanding of communities, how the world they live in works and develop technological skills. Whilst exploring these areas, learners will be subjected to key vocabulary to help build up their breadth of experiences and knowledge.	Mathematics QUIGS learners will know how to problem solve and Children should develop a deep conceptual understanding of the numbers and links between them. They will be given opportunities to develop a secure base of knowledge from which mathematical mastery is built.
