Following the emergence of the Omicron variant of COVID-19 in the UK, the Prime Minister mentioned that new measures will be introduced as a precaution to help slow down the spread of the variant while the government gathers more information.

In light of this news, as of Monday 29th November, face coverings will be required to be worn at school in communal areas by all our staff, visitors and students in year 7 and above, unless they are exempt. Students in year 7 or above should also continue to wear face coverings on public transport, unless they are exempt.

We strongly encourage all students to test twice weekly using lateral flow device (LFD) tests.

Why do we need a booster?

- The booster is there to give your immunity a reminder to fight back if COVID shows up
- Many vaccines need a booster; COVID is no different



What vaccine is the booster?

- Everyone will have Pfizer no matter what they had as their first vaccine
- The vaccine itself is the same thing as the original Pfizer vaccine



How to get the booster

- Boosters will be offered 6 months after your 2nd dose
- When you're eligible you will get a text message inviting you to get the booster
- The text message will have a link to book
- You can also walk in to specific places offering the booster

Side effects of the booster

- Some people will have short term side effects from the booster
- Do what you normally do to manage pain (eg take pain relief)
