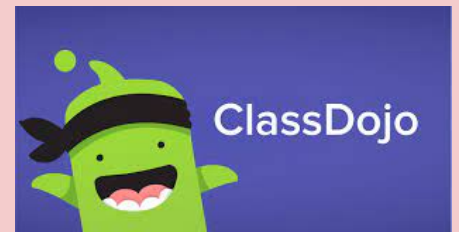

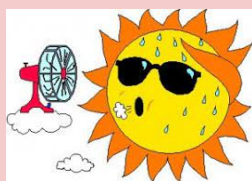

Hot weather



As the weather is forecast to be very hot over the next few days please ensure your daughter brings a water bottle to school. It is very important that students stay hydrated. Hydration has been associated with energy levels and physical endurance, as well as concentration and focus. To enable our children to get the most out of every day, staying hydrated is, therefore, both logical and important for a balanced mood and your child's wider health.

Ideally, please apply sunscreen to your child before they come to school on hot days. The long lasting protection types are recommended.

We are happy for secondary students to take off their blazers in class during lessons with the teachers permission but they will need to wear them when walking around the school building.

We will also encourage children to sit in the shade where necessary during break-times.
