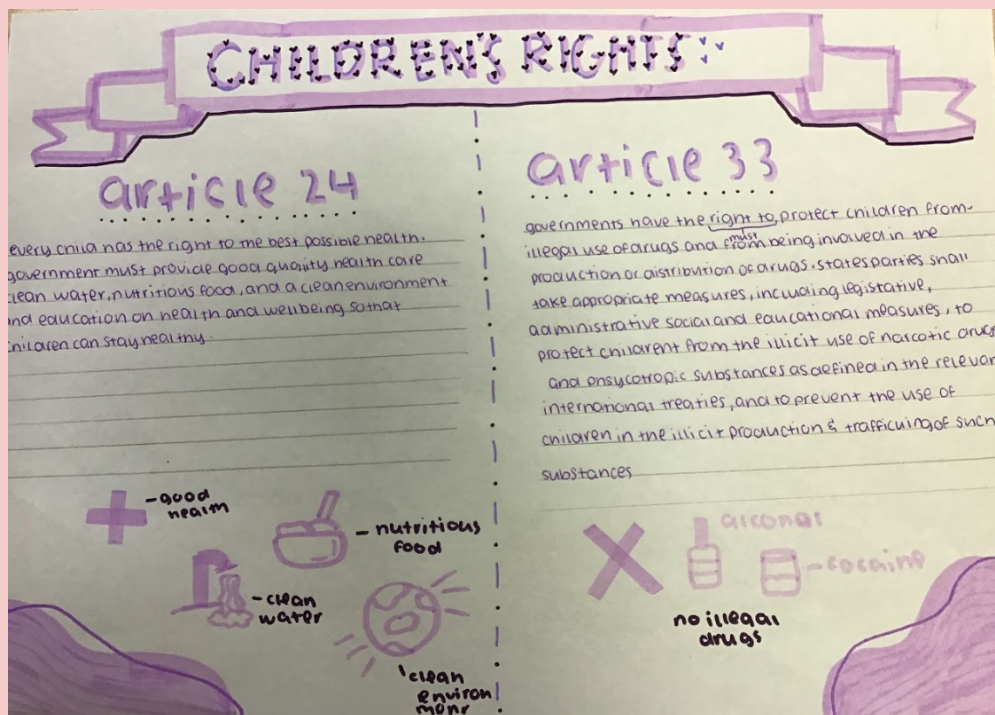


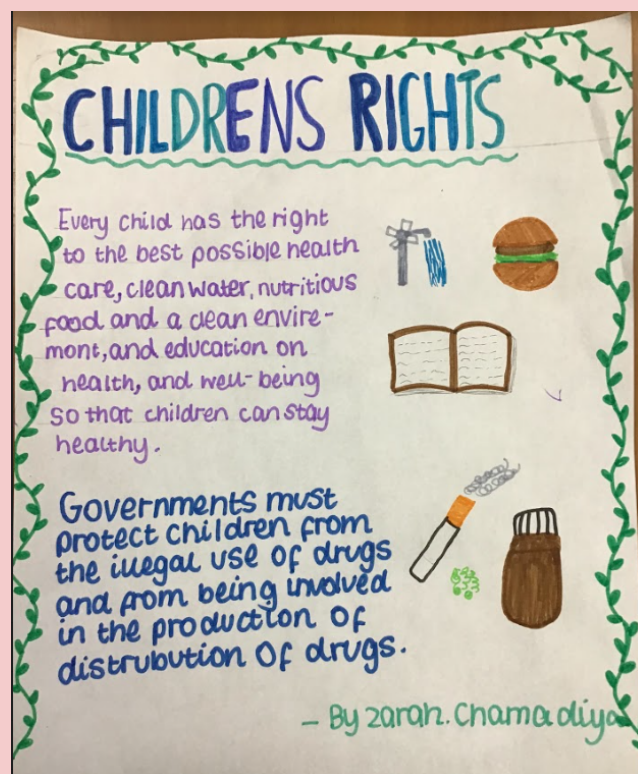
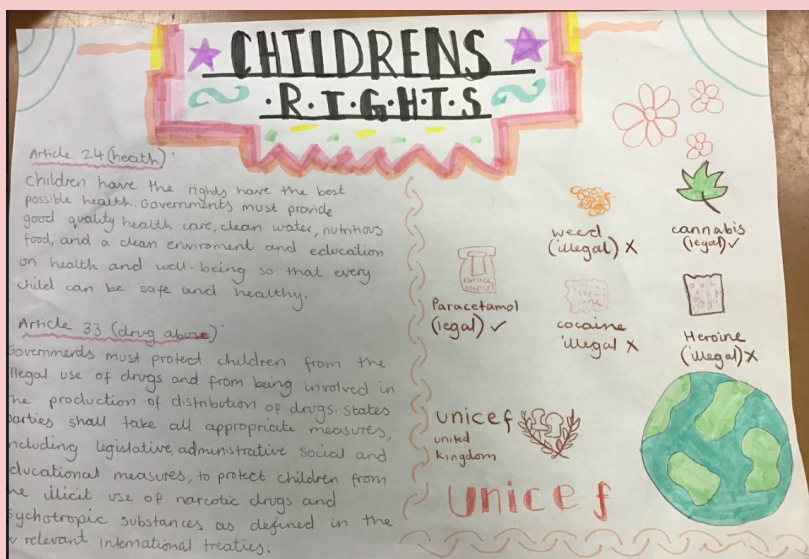
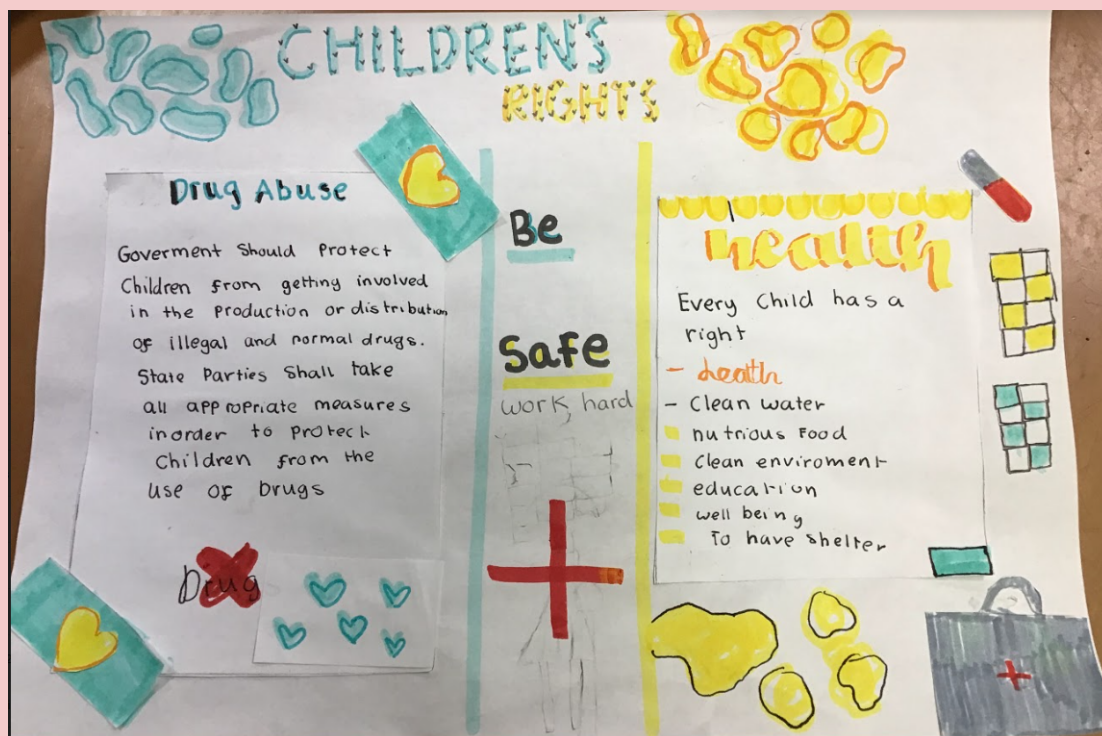
The students have been learning about children's health relating to **UNICEF articles 24 and 33**:
