We would appreciate it if you could ensure all clothing, bags and PE pumps are clearly labelled. JazakAllah Khair.

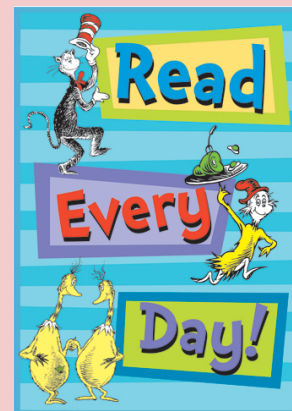

Science

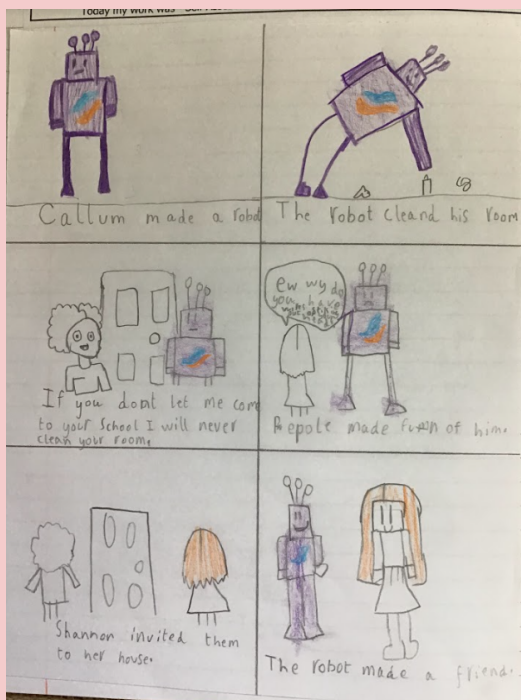
Year 3 have started their new Science topic: Plants.
