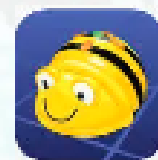

How to enter

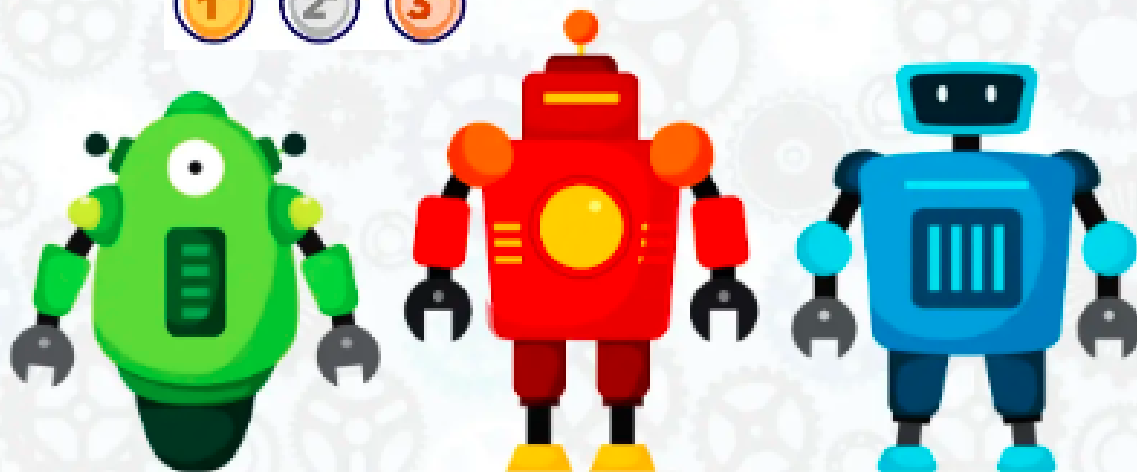
- **Design and create your own robot**

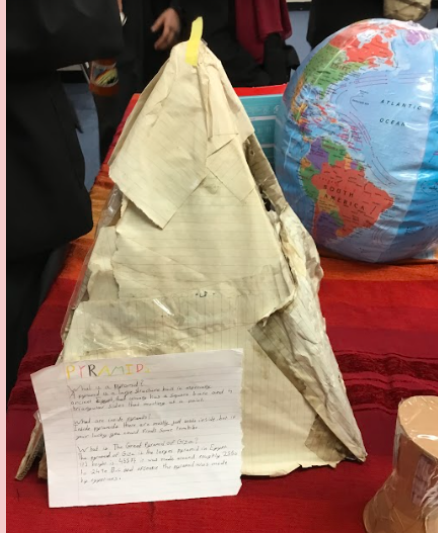
