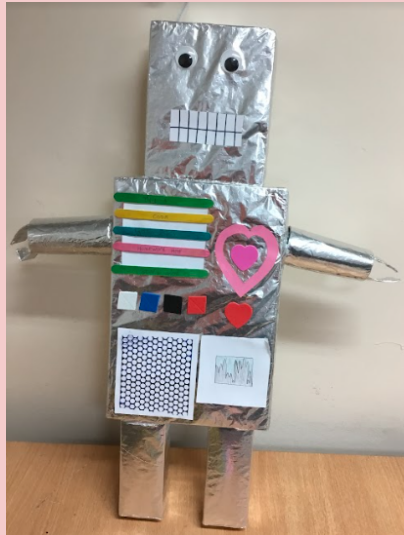

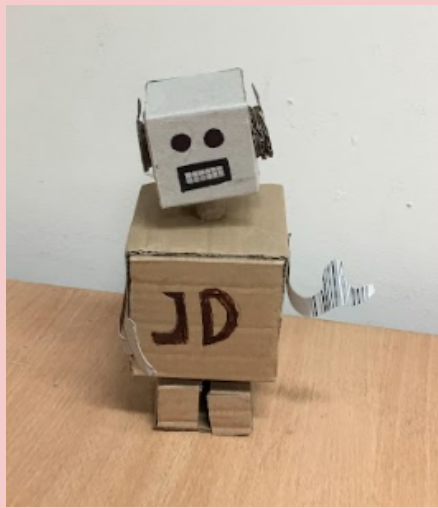

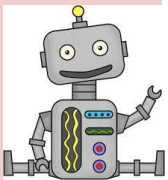

COVID WINTER 2022

The COVID-19 vaccine is available for free to anyone aged 5 years old and over. If you haven't had any COVID-19 vaccines yet it's not too late to get yours.

What vaccines are available?

- Under 18s: Pfizer
- Adults who need first or second dose: Pfizer
- Boosters: Pfizer and Moderna

(All booster vaccines have been updated to target both the Omicron variant and the original Covid-19 virus)

Who is eligible and what do they get?

AGE	VACCINE
Children 5-11	Two doses of paediatric Pfizer 12 weeks apart
Children 12-15	Two doses of Pfizer 12 weeks apart
16 years+	Two doses of Pfizer 8 weeks apart

When can you get a booster?

- Children aged 5 and over who are at high risk from COVID-19: three months after their second vaccine.
- Aged 16 and over: one booster three months after their second (or most recent booster) vaccine.

Booster for high risk groups

The Autumn 2022 booster is available to people who are at high risk from COVID-19 three months after their previous vaccine:

- Aged 50 and over
- Aged 5 and over who are in a clinical risk group
- Care home residents
- Frontline health & social care workers
- Unpaid carers (16-49 years old)
- Household of immunocompromised people

Note: People who are high risk or immunocompromised may have been offered additional vaccines and boosters.

Without this evidence you risk being issued with a penalty notice.
