Year 10 and Year 11 attended an apprenticeship fair on Thursday the 9th of February at Newham Money, at Stratford Place, as part of their post 16 careers programme. They had an insight into what future jobs may look like and explored possible job opportunities offered following an apprenticeship course.

The students learnt about different sectors, met some apprentices and heard about their journey. They gained an understanding of the many different types of apprenticeship courses that exist, from intermediate Level 2 (18 months max) to Level 7 (six years max), what they pay and the careers they may lead to. They also found out about an employer's recruitment process and got tips on completing an application form.
