Working with a mentor, students had the opportunity to apply learning from their programme to provide a fresh perspective, analyse specific company/market issues and develop solutions that have real-world impact.

As part of the project, students formed their own teams, which they remain part of for the whole experience. The company project champion and mentor presented the project brief, clarifying scope, objectives and expected deliverables of the project on Monday, with a final presentation and live feedback on Friday, where all team members participated. 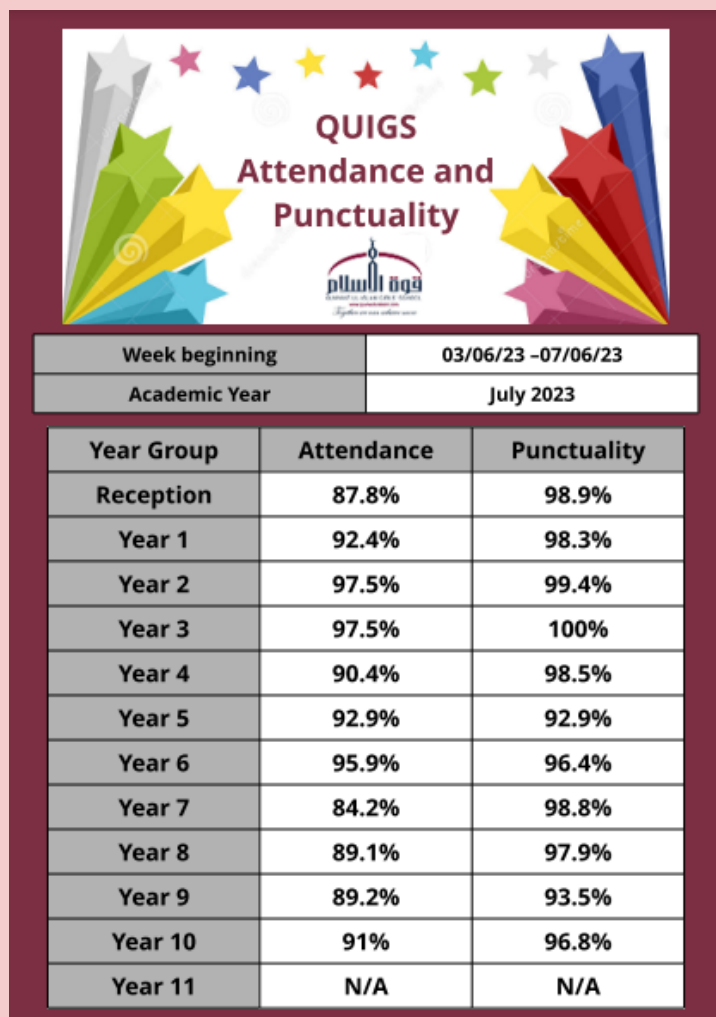
