We would appreciate it if you could ensure all clothing, bags and PE pumps are clearly labelled. JazakAllah Khair.

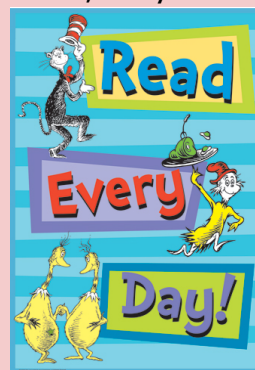

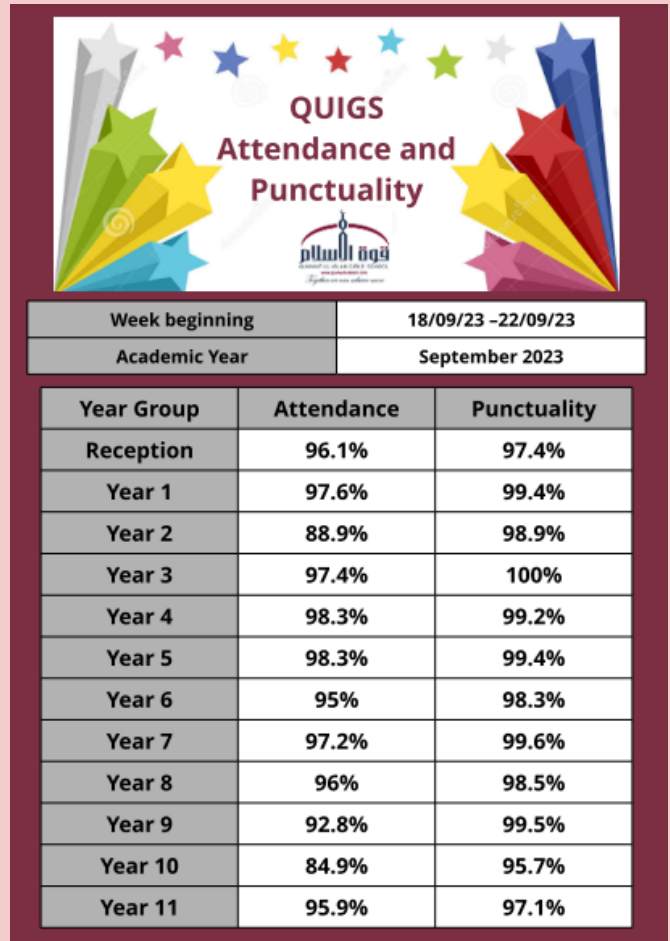
