Welcome back to another half term. I pray you all had a lovely and restful break.

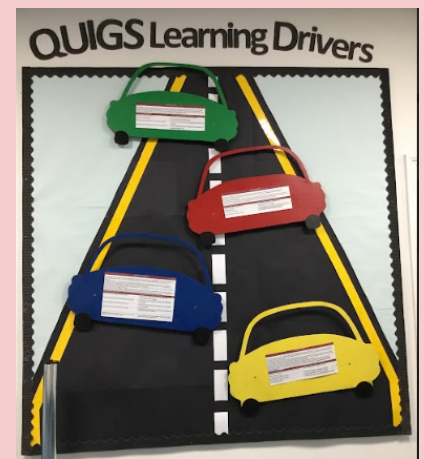
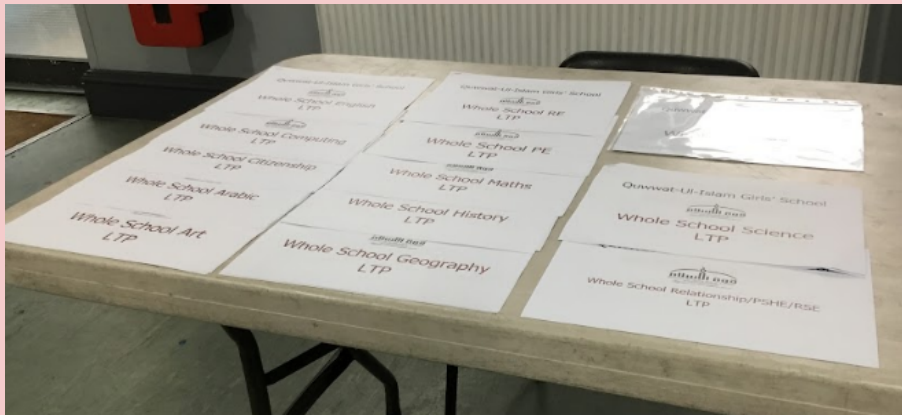
