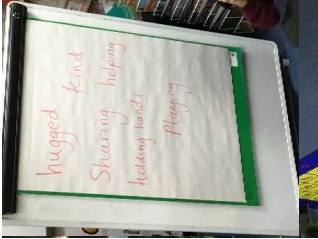

Right to healthy lifestyle - Fruit salad - Students will learn about food hygiene, wash their fruit before they start to prepare the salad and all their utensils, they will then choose what they want to add to their fruit salad, next they will chop it up, support/supervision will be given throughout the activity, they will mix it and enjoy their fruit salad.	Students enjoyed the activity very much especially as many of them had not prepared food before, the students said "chopping the apples was hard because the apple was hard, the grapes were hard because they kept splitting, they split because they were slippery and they moved away, I enjoyed chopping the strawberries because they were soft and that made it easy to chop.  They also said "the strawberries tasted like blueberries because they were mixed up with the other fruit, it tasted yummy, it tasted delicious, when the fruit was all mixed up it tasted sweet, the tangerines tasted sour, the bananas had a peel we had to peel it and then cut it, it was soft to cut and easier."
Right to Love and Compassion - students to talk about what makes them feel loved and cared, the actions, gestures and words that are used to make them feel loved by their family, Students will have a tree that has been made prior to the activity, this is so that they make hand prints, they will colour/design their hand print and cut around it, they will then write words and short sentences to say what makes them feel loved and cared for.
