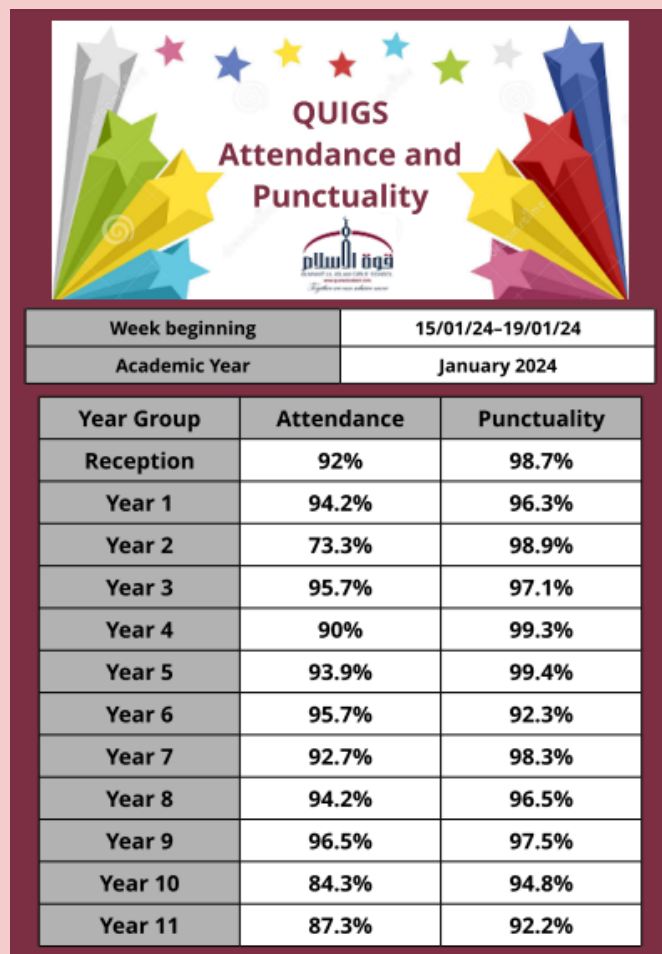

KS2 SATs Mock Exam timetable

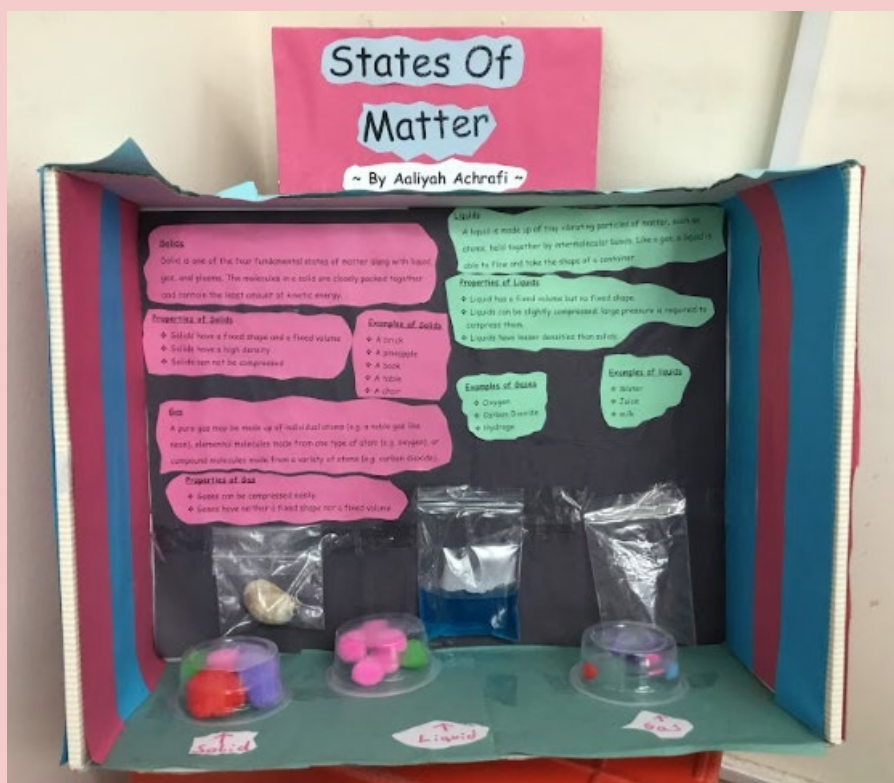
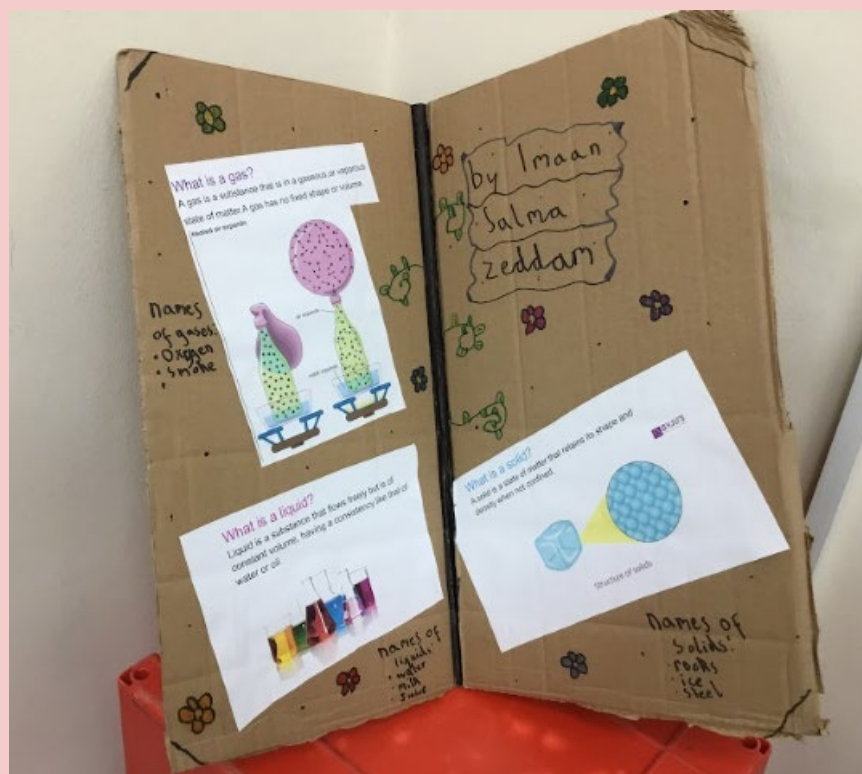
