Primary Uniform

Primary uniform consists of:

- ❑ Grey dress worn with grey trousers/Grey leggings/Grey tights
- ❑ White shirt /Polo shirt
- ❑ Grey abaya
- ❑ Black shoes
- ❑ Black socks
- ❑ Burgundy cardigan (please see links below for retailers')
- ❑ Burgundy Slip on hijab

The following are NOT allowed

- ❑ Sequins, brocade etc.
- ❑ Fancy brooches, bows or headbands
- ❑ Jewellery, except for a watch (jewellery will be confiscated and parents will be asked to pick it up within 6 months or the item will be disposed of).
- ❑ Make-up/nail varnish
- ❑ Coloured contact lenses
- ❑ Nose studs
- ❑ Trainers/heels/open toed shoes/sandals
- ❑ Hoodie

PE kit

- P.E. bag
- Burgundy jogging bottoms
- Burgundy slip on hijab
- Black plimsolls



Please note: For health and safety reasons, the full PE Kit must be worn during PE lessons. This should be brought into school at the beginning of the week and taken at the end of the week to be washed and to be ready for the following lesson. Parents are advised to clearly label their child's uniform. This will help to recover any misplaced items.

All children must look presentable when attending school. Please ensure that all uniforms such as Abaya, trousers, hijabs are ironed. All pupils must wear the uniform correctly or risk a series of consequences. We reserve the right to send children home if they are not dressed appropriately. We expect parents to encourage their children to wear the correct uniform and support school rules.

Blazer

QUIGS black blazer must be worn at all times around the school building. Please note that a jumper or hoodie cannot be worn instead of a blazer.

Hijab

A maroon hijab can be purchased from the school office

- Hijab should be wrapped over the head once and pinned securely
- High buns/big artificial buns, with extra hair bands or scarves around them in order to add volume are not allowed



Trousers/leggings to be worn under abaya

Trousers must be:

- ❑ Plain black
- ❑ Straight cut
- ❑ Medium width/regular fit
- ❑ Full length
- ❑ Black full length leggings

The following are not allowed:

- ❑ Denim trousers
- ❑ Skinny style trousers
- ❑ Trousers made of any fabric other than standard school trouser fabric
- ❑ Pyjama bottoms
- ❑ long johns
- ❑ Jogging bottoms
- ❑ thick tights

Plain black socks must be worn (Patterned socks are not acceptable).

Please note that sports socks or socks that do not cover the ankles are not permissible.

School shoes

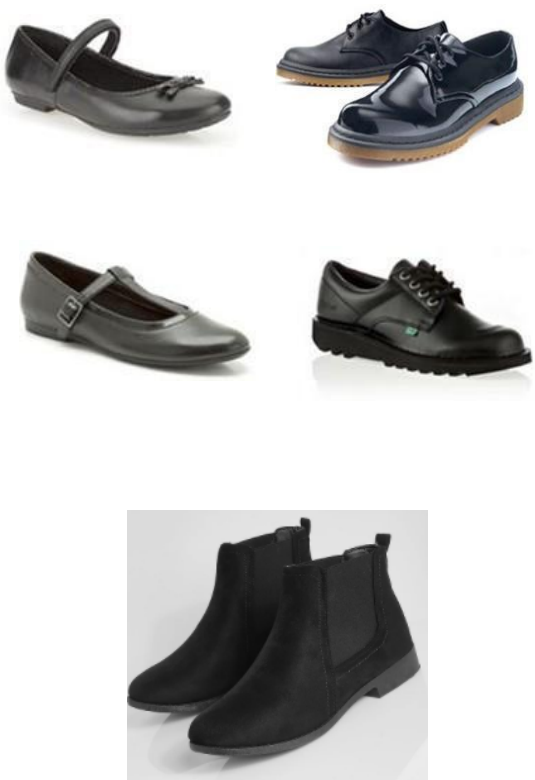
The only acceptable school shoes at Quwwat Ul Islam Girls' School are:
Plain black sensible flat shoes (plimsolls or trainers are not allowed).

Unacceptable footwear includes:

- ❑ Nike Air Forces
- ❑ Converse/Vans
- ❑ Sliders
- ❑ black trainers
- ❑ High heels
- ❑ Open toed sandals
- ❑ Boots during the summer season

If a student needs to wear alternative footwear, they will need to provide a medical note signed by a doctor.

Please note: Flat black ankle Chelsea boots may be worn during the winter season only, no wellington boots must be worn at school.

School Bags

School bags should be an appropriate size for school books (up to A4 size) and equipment.

Jewellery

No jewellery, apart from:

- ❑ A pair of plain silver or gold stud earrings to be worn in the lobe of the ear
- ❑ No other piercings are permitted including nose studs/rings
- ❑ Rings and bracelets are not permitted
- ❑ Clear 'retainer' piercings are not allowed
- ❑ Piercings covered with plasters are not allowed
- ❑ Students will be required to remove any jewellery before returning to lessons or alternatively be sent home to remove the piercing before returning to school

Makeup and nails

Make up is not allowed and should not be worn, this includes lip gloss. Coloured nail varnish, false nails and false eyelashes are not allowed. Nails should be kept short and trimmed weekly (Fridays).

Outerwear

Sensible school coat in a dark colour must be worn

- ❑ No leather or denim jackets
- ❑ No hoodies allowed at any time
- ❑ No sweatshirts, tracksuit tops or cardigans

Sanctions

Any student who is not following the school's uniform rules will be:

- Issued an on the spot 15-minute detention after school
- Will be sent home and must return to school in correct uniform
