May Allah guide all the Year 11 students. Ameen.

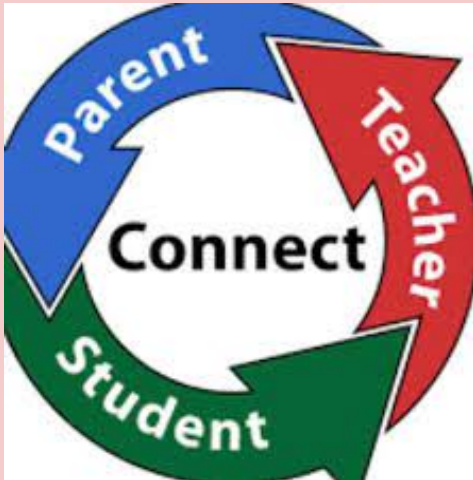

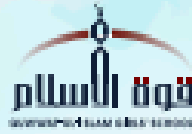
