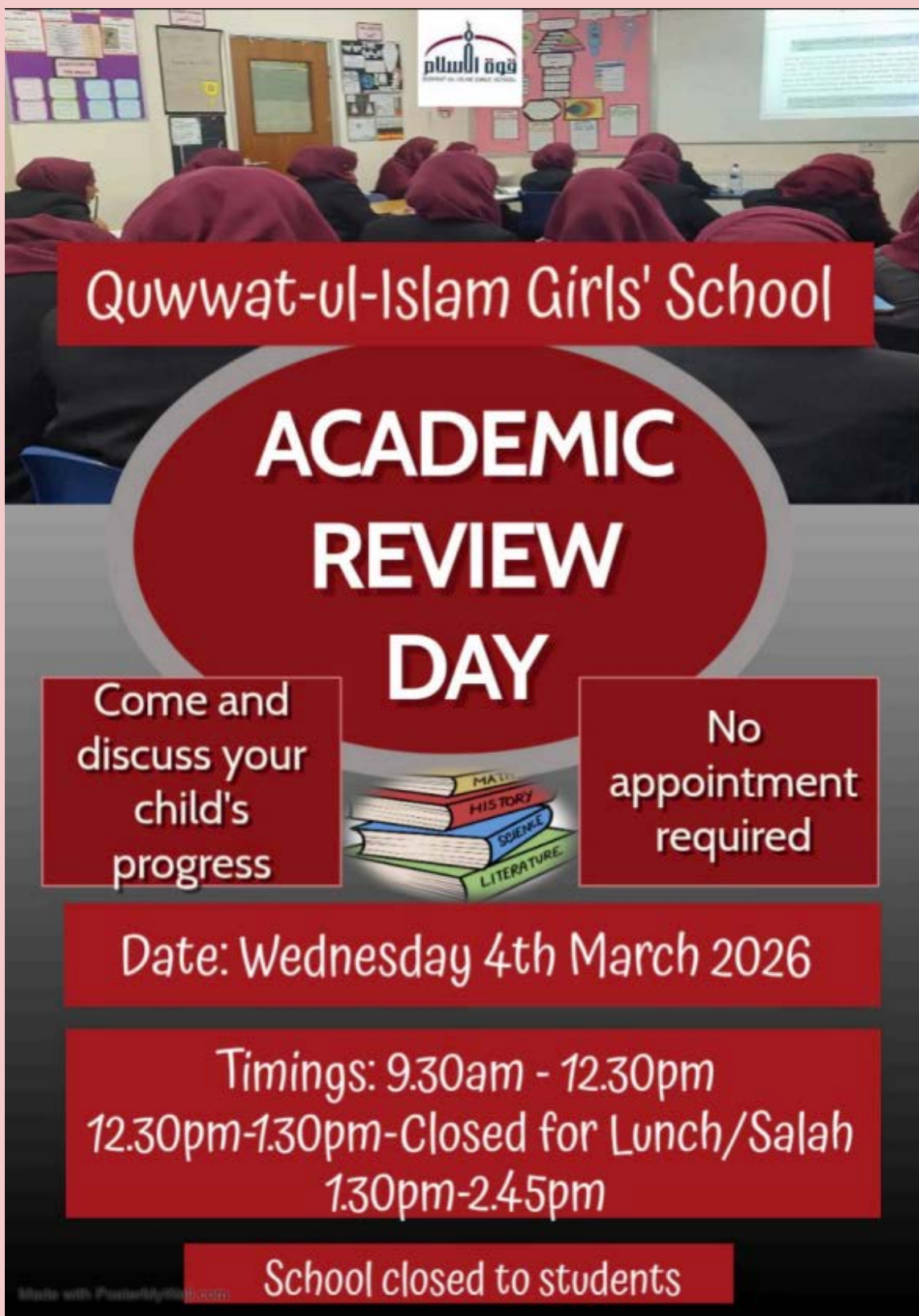

Protecting Newham Families: MMR Vaccination Update

Although the London Borough of Newham is not currently experiencing a measles outbreak, neighbouring boroughs are seeing a rise in cases. We are taking a proactive approach to help ensure that families in Newham remain protected.

We have produced a new MMR awareness poster highlighting the importance of vaccination and sharing details of our upcoming community catch-up clinics. These clinics are available to any child who is eligible and has not yet received their MMR vaccine.

The MMR vaccine is safe, effective, and the best way to protect children against measles, mumps and rubella. If your child has missed one or both doses, we encourage you to attend one of our catch-up clinics.

Measles is spreading

MMR vaccine is available for those who have not received both doses of the MMR as an infant

Children who aren't fully vaccinated are at serious risk of complications such as ear infections, pneumonia, and, in rare cases, brain inflammation.

Check your child's MMR vaccinations today

- The MMR vaccine protects against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella
- Two doses give the best protection
- If you're unsure whether your child is up to date, ask your GP or practice nurse



We are able to vaccinate for MMR at our catch-ups and while visiting the schools or at a community clinic.
